

<b>Assessment Tools</b>	<b>Direct/Indirect</b>	<b>Description</b>
Employer Survey	Indirect	Provides the information of the curriculum programs and course outcomes, on job fields specific information about the application and value of the skills that the program offers. Also helps in determining if the graduates of the course have necessary skill jobs and if some other skill jobs that the employer values but the graduates are not acquiring through the program.
Alumni Survey	Indirect	Collection of variety of information about the program satisfaction, how well students are prepared for their careers, type of jobs graduates majors have gone to acquire as well as the set of skills that are needed to succeed in the job market, 3 years after graduation.
Course Exit Survey	Indirect	To determine the quality of course, its various outcomes as well as the course satisfaction and level of achievement of the outcomes.
Course Evaluation	Direct	It provides information about what and how the students are learning within the classroom environment using existing information that the faculty collect on regular basis such as tests, assignments etc.
Student Exit Survey	Indirect	To evaluate success of programme in providing the students opportunity to achieve respective program outcomes.
Project and Training Evaluation	Direct	It gives a demonstration of the abilities of the students throughout the program.
